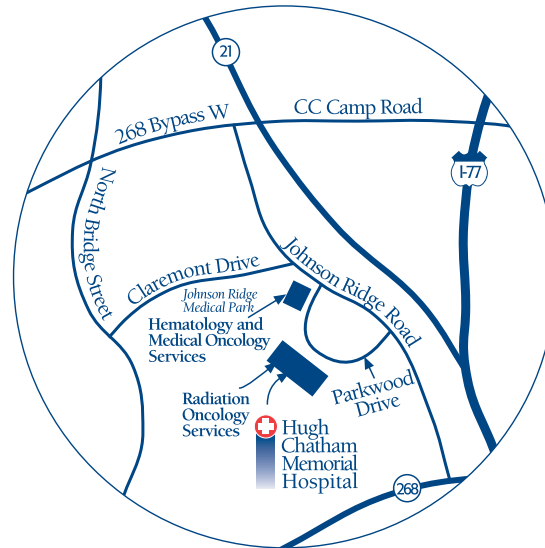

Radiation Oncology

State-of-the-art radiation therapy is available right here at Hugh Chatham Memorial Hospital. That means that patients receiving treatment, and their families, can avoid the added burden of travel to a distant treatment center. The Radiation Oncology Department at Hugh Chatham's Cancer Center provides technology treatments identical to those at large urban medical centers.

Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy (IMRT)

The Regional Cancer Center at Hugh Chatham Memorial Hospital is now offering patients improved chances for cancer cure with fewer side effects. A state-of-the-art approach called Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy, or IMRT, uses computer-generated radiation dose calculations. The radiation beam intensity is varied, or modulated, to allow very precise dose delivery.

The clinical use of IMRT shows great promise for cancer. The treatment is especially
